Even stream and Labrador violets have their virtues; they are certainly prettier than shot weed.

Other ideas for groundcovers are sedums, pachysandra, kinnikinnick, ornamental strawberries, hostas, ferns, beesia, primroses, hardy impatiens and the ever favorite easy care rocks and driftwood.



Our garden is filled with rocks from all over the world. Wherever we travel, we pick up rocks some large, some small and place them in the garden. They add color, character and cover the soil. Sedums and other small plants can be nestled in the crannies between the rocks. Have a space where nothing you've tried grows well? Try rocks or plantings in containers.

Things to Do in the Garden-May and June

- ➤ It's time to plant vegetables, tomatoes, peppers, basil other herbs and warm season crops.
- > Prune lilacs, rhododendrons, azaleas, pieris right after bloom.
- Fertilize plantings as needed.
- > Catch up on weeding and apply compost as needed to nourish the soil.
- ➤ Divide spring blooming primroses. For tips you can watch a video from our friends at NPA http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YV32v550BSg
- > Clean the birdbaths and refill with fresh water on a regular basis.
- ➤ Hummingbirds babies will be here soon, Clean and refill feeders with a mixture of 1 part sugar to 4 parts water.
- > Prepare and prime irrigation systems. When the rains taper off, give gardens an inch of water a week.



Need help or advice? Bring in pictures of your garden to the nursery and we'll give you some tips. We can also show you plants with year-round interest to make your garden pop with color, even on a grey day.
