Many thanks to those of you who inquired about our well-being in the recent snow storm and flood. The snow did some damage to trees in our display/test garden, but most of it is repairable with some judicious pruning.

Despite the extensive national news coverage, the flood here at Lael's Moon Garden was only a near miss, and nothing like last year. There was little flood damage in the nursery (some mud and tipped over pots) and no damage to the house, outbuildings or vehicles. We learned from last year's flood and we were much better prepared this year. We had time to move things to high ground and sandbag and the flood was less, so we are in good shape. The two nursery employees who live in flood zones also fared well with no serious damage.

Attached are some pictures taken around the nursery and gardens Friday morning. The water has now gone down here for the most part.

Our hearts go out to others in Centralia, Chehalis, Adna, Bucoda and surrounding areas who did suffer considerable damage for the second year in a row. We hope you and yours were not among them. We'll be making a contribution to the American Red Cross for their flood relief efforts and we encourage you to do the same. Contributions can be mailed to:
