Botanical names are most helpful as common names can be confusing.

We have many sizes of Nordmann firs (*Abies nordmanniana*), a few Grand firs (*Abies grandis*) and Frazier firs (*Abies fraseri*). A living Christmas tree can be kept inside for a couple of weeks and then moved outside for planting to be enjoyed in your landscape for many years. You could also purchase a tree to be used as your Christmas tree and then donate
